The Borough Attorney read Resolution #2023-143 into the Record. Mr. Moench said that the Governing Body previously hired two officers. The original Resolution indicated that the hires were contingent upon certain things such as passing a background check, a physical, and completion of the Police Academy. The Bergen County Prosecutor's Office wanted to make sure that word "probationary hiring" was explicitly in the Resolution to make it clear that they were on probationary status. The Governing Body was meeting in order to clarify that the hiring of the two Police Officers was for a probationary status subject to the conditions that all officers need to meet. The goal was to get these Police Officers into the upcoming Police Academy, which would start in July.

Councilman Vietri asked if Mr. Moench could fax or email the Resolution so that there was something in writing. Mr. Moench confirmed that he would send it over immediately to the Clerk so that the written Resolution could be executed.

RESOLUTION CLARIFYING PROBATIONARY STATUS OF RECENTLY HIRED POLICE OFFICERS

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2023, the Borough of Palisades Park passed Resolutions 2023-123 and 2023-124, hiring Bob Sangwon Lee and Julio Roberto Mancilla, Jr. as police officers for the Borough of Palisades Park; and

WHEREAS, Resolutions 2023-123 and 2023-124 contained conditions of employment, including that the officers must complete a psychological evaluation, complete all prescribed pre-hiring reviews under the Borough's personnel procedures, including, but not limited to background checks, and

WHEREAS, both officers need to be enrolled and complete police training through the Police Academy, which begins in July, and

WHEREAS, while the term "probationary" does not expressly appear in Resolution 2023-123 or 2023-124, it was always intended that the employment status of Lee and Mancilla be probationary until the completion of all necessary training, background checks, and physical and psychological evaluations, and

WHEREAS, the Bergen County Prosecutor's office has requested that the Borough of Palisades Park pass a new resolution to specifically indicate that the police hires are probationary, as required by N.J.SA. 52:17B-68 and N.J.S.A. 52:17B-69.2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough Council of the Borough of Palisades Park hereby incorporates Resolutions 2023-123 and 2023-124 herein, and explicitly clarifies that the hiring of Bob Sangwon Lee and Julio Roberto Mancilla, Jr. are probationary until the completion of all prerequisites to unrestricted employment, including but not limited to completion of background checks, psychological evaluations, physical finesses assessment, and completion of required training at the police academy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Police Chief is directed to immediately take all steps necessary to ensure that Officers Lee and Mancilla are enrolled in the upcoming July police academy class, including processing their background checks and all other administrative actions necessary to avoid any further delay in their hiring process.
