Susan Brauer asked what would happen if there were not enough people for a Special Meeting on Thursday. The meeting would not happen and this would be carried to the next ensuing meeting of the Mayor and Council.

Lois Grato asked how many more meetings there could be where the Council people do not show up. Mr. Collins said there was a State law that provided that if a Councilmember missed four meetings over a span of several months, and there was no medical excuse, there was a procedure for the Governing Body to remove the Councilmember. However, this was not the scenario presented at the meeting.

Youbong Won-Yoon said she did not understand this Ordinance. Mr. Lorenzo answered that this was for road detail work for off-duty Police Officers. This would set the rates to be paid.

Soo Chung asked if off-duty Police Officers could campaign for elections. This was not a question that pertained to the Ordinance. Mr. Collins provided an example to the public. If a utility company was repairing a broken pole, an off-duty Police Officer could be utilized.

COUNCIL REPORTS:

Councilman Park had no report.

Councilman Vietri reported that the PD had an attempted hold up at the bank. PPPD and the FBI investigated, went to NYC, apprehended the suspect, and he was in jail. The PD did a great job. The FD was busy the last few months. They went to mutual aid calls to Ridgefield and Leonia.

Councilman Min had no report.

Borough Administrator Lorenzo had no report.

Chief Espino reported on the Junior Police Academy. Sgt. Messing was one of the lead instructors. Regarding the bank incident, Espino reported that a male gentleman passed a note to the bank teller requesting \$5,000 cash. The bank teller sent an email to her boss who was in the next room over. He came out and talked to her. The suspect took off. When he left, he pushed on the door, but he was not wearing gloves. The Sheriff's Department was able to retrieve a palm print, and they were able to locate the suspect. FBI got involved and worked with the Detective Bureau and processed him. The suspect admitted that he attempted to rob the bank during the interview.

The Chief said that summertime was hot for burglaries. He stated that residents should cut side bushes back because this was where burglars would hide. The cameras should stay activated. He asked residents to say something if they saw something. A resident who lived on Glen Ave said that there were cars that were parked for long periods of time on the street. The Chief stated that most of those cars were limo services waiting to get a call. If it did not look right, the Chief asked that the police be called.

The Mayor stated that he wanted to reignite the Neighborhood Watch Program.

The Mayor stated that the accidents on cross intersections were still happening. He requested that the Chief create a plan to reduce the amount of accidents. Captain Gasparovich stated that the shrubbery was being cut back close to stop signs for greater visibility. There were some no parking signs in close proximity to stop signs so it could obstruct vision. There were steps being taken to alleviate the issues. The Mayor said he wanted to see results.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:

Councilman Min made a motion to open to the public. Councilman Park seconded. The motion carried. All present in favor by voice vote; none opposed.

Soo Chung spoke about a car accident that occurred on June 1st near her house, where her SUV was crushed. She asked if the Mayor and Council could do anything about the dangers of car accidents on Central Blvd. She asked why the Mayor and Council did not disclose the two names of the police officers who were hired last month. She asked if the meeting time was changed to 5:30 P.M. Chief Espino stated that he spoke with Ms. Chung about the car accident. Mr. Collins stated that this may be an open investigation and police tactics should not be discussed in public. The two names of the Police Officers were disclosed. They were Bob Sangwon Lee and Julio Mancilla Jr. The meeting time was 6:00 P.M. except for when the Governing Body scheduled Executive Sessions.

Marsha asked about #2023-151. She wanted to know why the fees were being waived. The Mayor stated that there was inflation and recession where people did not want to eat outside. This was to help bolster the commerce. The permits would still have to be applied for. She asked about #2023-161 and bicycle lanes. Mr. Lorenzo answered.

Susan Brauer asked about a Special Meeting that took place last Thursday. Mr. Lorenzo answered. She asked about the Streetscape Project. She wanted to know what Phase I and II was. Mr. Lorenzo answered that it was for the beautification of Broad Ave. She asked about #2023-160. Mr. Lorenzo said that whatever monies and revenues the Borough got, it would be property tax relief.

Peter Longo said that three or four months ago that all jobs should be posted on the website. An employment opportunity section was not added. He stated that many people in town were unemployed. He said that no changes were being made. A few weeks ago, two police positions were filled. He was told there was no advertisement for these positions. He requested that more information be placed on the Borough website. Mr. Collins stated that the Council would take his comments under advisement. There was no specific legal requirement to provide for Mr. Longo's suggestions. He was upset that other people were not given an opportunity to apply for certain jobs.

Youbong Won-Yoon said she agreed with Mr. Longo to utilize the website. She wanted to have an update regarding the mold issue at Borough Hall. Mr. Collins stated that given the fact that that issue involved personnel and potential litigation, it would not be appropriate for the Council to discuss the matter in public.

Councilman Min made a motion to close to the public. Councilman Vietri seconded. All present in favor by voice vote; none opposed.

RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR S-3906 WHICH WOULD PROVIDE THE BOROUGH OF PALISADES PARK WITH \$6,553,562.20 OF STATE FUNDS TO REPAY DEBT, ADVANCE CAPITAL PROJECTS, AND PROVIDE PROPERTY TAX RELIEF

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Debt Defeasance and Prevention Fund was created for the purpose of repaying or defeasing taxpayer-funded debt and funding capital projects that would otherwise be paid for with new debt; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Debt Defeasance and Prevention Fund is expected to have an unallocated balance of at least \$4.32 billion; and

WHEREAS, members of the New Jersey Senate Republican caucus, including Senator Schepisi, have introduced Senate Bill 3906 (S-3906), which would allocate \$4.32 billion from the New Jersey Debt Defeasance and Prevention Fund to towns and counties to repay local government debt, advance capital projects of their choosing, and provide property tax relief to residents; and

WHEREAS, funds would be allocated by S-3906 on a per capita basis, meaning every town and county would get a fair share of funding based on population; and

WHEREAS, S-3906 provides that \$3 billion would be allocated to New Jersey municipalities on a per capita basis, and \$1.32 billion would be allocated to New Jersey counties on a per capita basis; and

WHEREAS, prior allocations from the New Jersey Debt Defeasance and Prevention fund have not been determined in a fair, equitable, or transparent manner; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Palisades Park would receive an estimated allocation of \$6,553,562.20 million under S-3906 based on 2020 United States Census data; and

WHEREAS, S-3906 requires funds to be disbursed within 30 days of the legislation's enactment; and

WHEREAS, S-3906 is not expected to have a fiscal impact on the proposed State Budget for Fiscal Year 2024; and

WHEREAS, local and county governments are contending with soaring health care premiums, rising pension costs, and inflationary pressures that have impacted their budgets; and

WHEREAS, the significant allocations to towns and counties across New Jersey that have been proposed under S-3906 would help to lower and stabilize property taxes for years to come.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Palisades Park express their support for S-3906 which would provide the Borough of Palisades Park with \$6,553,562.20 of state funds to repay debt, advance capital projects, and provide property tax relief.
