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In addition, in our zone, it's also commercial recreation is permitted as-of-right, as a permitted use.

CHAIRMAN FERGUSON: Right.

THE WITNESS: So if you were looking at a use, like, an office, the shared parking situation wouldn't work out as well and the parking requirement would be 24, because then it would be based on square footage.

CHAIRMAN FERGUSON: Right.

THE WITNESS: So right now we're based on the number of seats and the employees.

So that's how your planner and your zoning officer come up with the number of parking spaces.

CHAIRMAN FERGUSON: Right.

THE WITNESS: The same thing would be done if it was an office use. And that would be one per 200 at 4700 square feet, we would be required to have 24, because it is 23.5 and you round up at 5.

So in that sense, this is more

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beneficial than actually a permitted use. It is a unique situation where the use variance is actually

less detrimental.

Again, some of the other permitted uses are warehousing, and things like that. You would have much more truck traffic in that situation.

Possibly backing in, backing out. I believe there's a garage door there now that actually faces East Palisades Boulevard and that we're taking it out to put an entry, you know, a client entry or patron entry.

So right now people could be using that as trucks. Then right next door, you do have that -- I guess it's a construction yard, because there's a lot of materials, a lot of trucks there now.

So we're taking that possibility away by promoting, you know, or proposing this use variance situation.

So in terms of the particular suitability, it could be viewed as an ancillary use. You know, there's -- when Ms. Kim had shown all of the photos --

Karaoke is not permitted as a principal use in those zones. The planning board views that as an ancillary or customarily accessory use to the restaurant and that is permitted in the B-1.

So the view is: The eating and drinking establishment part of the business takes precedence over everything. That is the main use. And the planning board views the karaoke aspect as an ancillary or accessory use.

Well, it's really the same thing here. We are permitted to have eating and drinking. It's just that in this zone it doesn't provide that use as an ancillary use. However, you do have principal permitted uses, such as bowling alleys and other recreation.

And I know it's -- people may not view this as realistic, but in land use terms it's really not much different than a group of people going and renting an alley. You have eating and drinking in bowling alleys. You have maybe four to six people, you know, using the lanes and so in terms of, like, a

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parking impact or anything like that, it's very similar to what's contemplated as a principal permitted use right now in that zone.

So, I think we meet the particular suitability aspect to it. It's located in an area of other commercial and restaurant uses. It's not adjacent or directly adjacent to any residential uses at all. The closest one at 12th Street is about 150 or even more than that.

So within -- and that would be to the south side. And then 350 feet on the north to the Trio. So you're not directly adjacent in anyway to a residential use.

So in terms of the particular suitability, we're in an area with lot of other restaurants, Baden Baden was converted to another restaurant, but it stayed karaoke. And that's only a block down the street.

We have Meson Madrid right next door. So eating and drinking establishments as a principal permitted use is located in that area.

It's just the karaoke aspect, which again really is only accessory to this, to this use.
