

NOTES: 1. DATUM: U.S.G.S. N.G.V.D. 1929. ENGINEERING PRACTICE AS PERTAINS TO SAFETY.

2. ALL CONSTRUCTION WORK MUST BE PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATION (OSHA), THE NEW JERSEY UNIFORM CONSTRUCTION CODE, AND GOOD CONSTRUCTION AND

3. NEW JERSEY RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING BLASTING OPERATIONS AND EXCAVATION SAFETY MUST BE FOLLOWED. PROVISIONS SHALL BE MADE FOR DUST CONTROL DURING ROCK DRILLING AND OTHER GRADING AND EXCAVATION OPERATIONS.

4. CURBS, DRIVEWAYS, SIDEWALKS AND STORM SEWERS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED TO BOROUGH SPECIFICATIONS.

5. ANY ADJACENT STRUCTURES, RETAINING WALLS, LANDSCAPING, CURB, PIPING, PAVEMENT, FENCES, ETC. DAMAGED DURING CONSTRUCTION MUST BE REPAIRED OR REPLACED.

6. ALL ROOF LEADERS SHALL BE TIED INTO PROPOSED DRAINAGE SYSTEM.

7. SANITARY & WATER SERVICE LINES TO BE 10 FT. APART.

8. CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE LOCATION AND DEPTHS OF ALL UTILITIES PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.

9. NO DIRECT SUMP PUMP DISCHARGE ONTO STREET OR TO ADJACENT PROPERTIES.

10. ANY DISCREPANCIES FOUND SHALL BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE ENGINEER.

11. SEPARATE UTILITY PERMIT APPLICATIONS WILL BE REQUIRED FOR EACH PROPOSED UTILITY WORK (GAS ELECTRIC, WATER, SEWER, ETC.) APPLICATIONS SHALL BE FILED WITH RESPECTIVE UTILITY COMPANY.

MAINTENANCE NOTES

1. MAINTENANCE OF STORMWATER SYSTEM: (1) MAINTENANCE OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY SHALL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER. (2) MAINTENANCE SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING: (A) PERIODIC CLEANING OF INLETS TO PREVENT DEBRIS FROM ENTERING THE DETENTION SYSTEM. (3 MONTH INTERVALS) (B) DETENTION SYSTEM & OUTLET CONTROL STRUCTURE SHALL BE INSPECTED (4) TIMES ANNUALLY AND MAINTAINED YEARLY.
