What's New? Block Style Voting!

- Contests are **grouped in easy-to-read blocks**.
- Each block has a shaded heading with the office up for election and how many candidates you can vote for in each block.
- Candidates running for the same office appear above and below each other in their office block.
- Each candidate has a **unique ballot position**. (Ex. 1A, 2A, 1B, 2B)
- Candidates for different offices who are affiliated with each other will share the same slogan, instead of the same column.

Why? Updates to Ballot Titles and Instructions

- Bill No. 5116 was signed into law on March 6, 2025
- Clear and Fair Ballots
- No candidate gets a preferential ballot placement** over another candidate running for the same office.
- Our enhancements to the ballots and instructions **reduce confusion and improve your voting experience** by making them clearer and easier to follow.

If you are not set up to receive one already, applications must be received in the mail by June 3, 2025 or in person by 3:00pm on June 9, 2025.

You may cast your vote by mail ballot by:

- **Mailing it in as soon as possible.** Your ballot must be postmarked on or before Primary Day or ...
- **Deposit in a Secure Ballot Drop Box** no later than 8pm on Primary Day. Drop box locations can be found here on the right hand side and at bergencountylvotes.com or ...
- **Deliver your Vote by Mail ballot in person to the Board of Elections** located at 1 Bergen County Plaza - Room 310 by 8pm on Primary Day.
