**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-21**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 282 OF THE CODE OF THE  
BOROUGH OF PALISADES PARK ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” TO INCLUDE THE  
PAYMENT OF SERVICE, MERCHANT AND PROCESSING FEES AS PARKING FEES.**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Palisades Park, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that Chapter 282: “Vehicles and Traffic” of the Code of the Borough of Palisades Park is hereby amended as follows (~~stricken~~ text deleted; underlined text added):

**CHAPTER 282: VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

**ARTICLE V: PARKING METERS**

\* \* \*

**§ 282-31      PARKING FEES.**

The Mayor and Council do hereby establish the following fees for the parking of vehicles in metered parking spaces:

<b>Zone</b>	<b>Coin Denomination</b>	<b>Parking Time Allowed per Coin (minutes)</b>
All zones (up to 2 hours)	\$0.25	15
Additional 2 hours up to 4-hour maximum	\$0.25	15

In addition to the parking fees, the Borough may charge merchant, service and processing fees related to the use of parking meters within the Borough.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that, if any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that, if any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that, if other parts, portions and provisions of the Code of the Borough of Palisades Park are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
